







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Figure 1. Structure of biogenic species used in this study

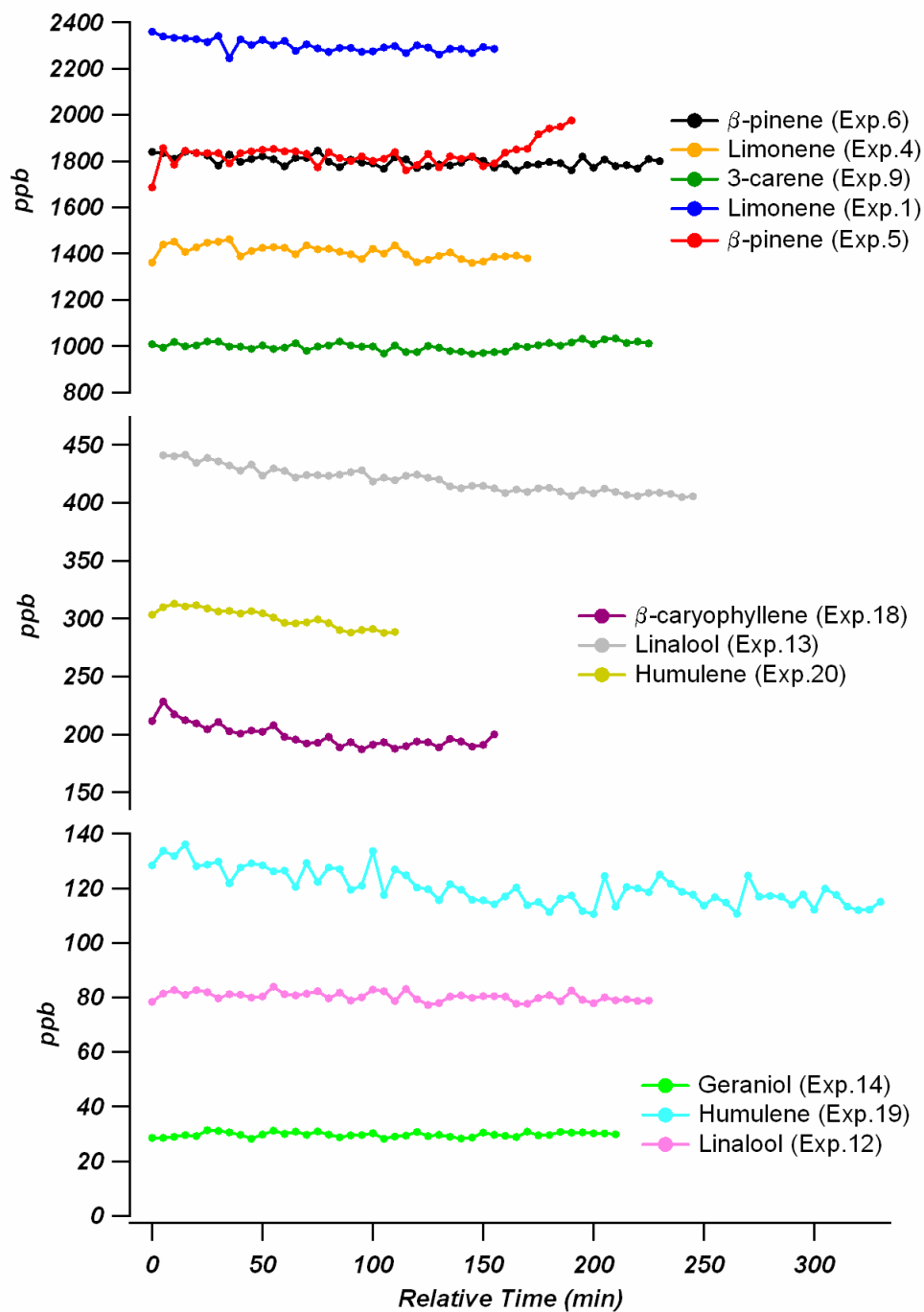


Figure 2. PTR-MS data for selected experiments (5 minute mean).
